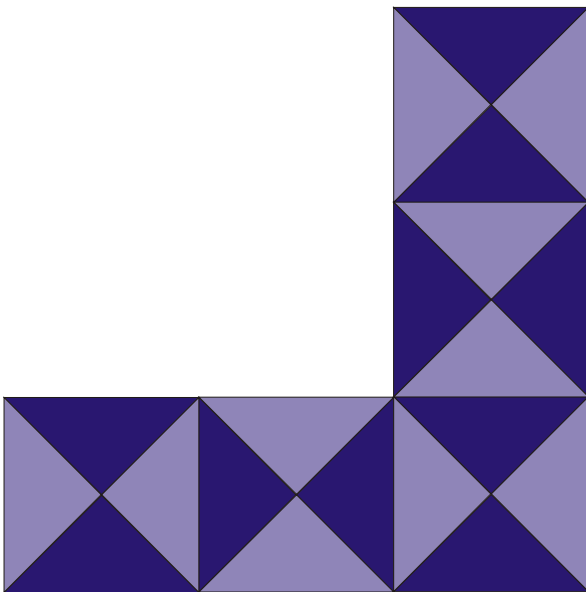


**2010 Block of the Month**  
**PERFECTLY PURPLE**  
Blocks 10 - Hour Glass Blocks



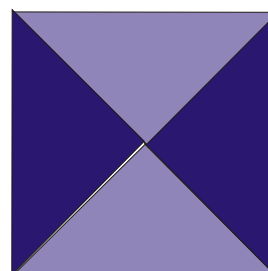
REQUIREMENTS

From dark purple fabric cut:-  
5 - 7½" squares

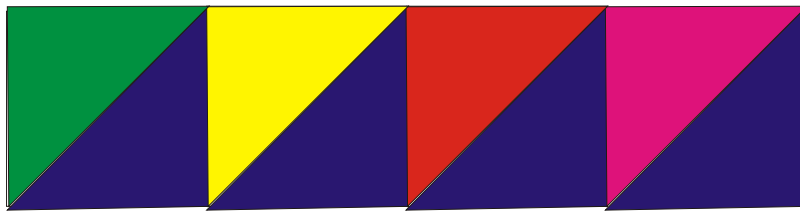
1. On the back of the light purple 7½" squares, draw diagonally from corner to corner.
2. Lay a dark purple 7½" square on a light purple 7½" square with right sides facing. Sew ¼" away, on both sides of drawn lines.
3. Now cut along diagonal drawn line.
4. Press open with seam towards the darker fabric.
5. Place these 2 squares on top of each other and make sure the seams "butt" up against each other. The light purple should be on the dark purple and the dark on the light. Rule another diagonal line from corner to corner and sew ¼" away from this. Cut along the diagonal line and press seam. You should have 2 - 6½" Blocks. You may need to trim these back.

Repeat with the other squares. Make 10 blocks.



## 2010 Block of the Month PERFECTLY PURPLE

### Blocks 10 - Half Square Triangles



#### REQUIREMENTS

From dark purple fabric cut:-  
2 - 5" squares, cut these squares in to triangles.

From assorted fabrics cut:-  
4 - 5" triangles.

Sew a dark purple triangle to an assorted triangle to make a half square triangle. Press to the dark side. These should measure 4½" squares. Make 4 of these.
