


2010 Block of the Month PERFECTLY PURPLE

Blocks 11 - Checker Board



REQUIREMENTS

From dark purple fabric cut:-
3 - 2½" x 8" strips

From light purple fabric cut:-
3 - 2½" x 8" strips

1. Sew a dark purple strip to each side of a light purple strip.
2. Sew a light purple strip to each side of a dark purple strip.
3. Press the seams to the dark fabric.
4. Cross cut strips into 2½" x 6½" rectangles. You should have 3 of each.




5. Using the diagram as a guide sew the rectangles together to form the checkerboard block.

Block should measure 12½" x 6½"

Blocks 11 - Flying Geese



REQUIREMENTS

From Dark Purple fabric cut:
3 - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and
1 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

From Pink fabric cut:
6 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From Light Purple fabric:
5 - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

From Orange fabric cut:
10 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

PIECING

1. Position a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Pink square on the corner of a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Purple rectangle and stitch diagonally from corner to corner on the Pink square. Trim the seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ", and press towards the dark side. Repeat for the opposite corner of the rectangle. Make a total of 3 units.

2. Using the diagram, sew these units together. Sew the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle on the end to complete the block. Press.

3. Position a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Orange square on the corner of a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Light Purple rectangle and stitch diagonally from corner to corner on the Orange square. Trim the seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ", and press towards the dark side. Repeat for the opposite corner of the rectangle. Make a total of 5 units.

2. Using the diagram, sew these units together. Press.
