


**2010 Block of the Month**  
**PERFECTLY PURPLE**

**Blocks 5 - Bear Paws and Twisted Star**




**REQUIREMENTS**

From yellow fabric cut:-

- 1 - 4 ½" square
- 2 - 4" squares diagonally cut into a total of 4 triangles.
- 8 - 3" squares


From purple fabric cut:-

- 2 - 5½" squares diagonally cut into a total of 4 triangles.
- 8 - 3" squares
- 4 - 2½" squares




1. Sew a purple 4" triangle to each edge of the 4 ½" square. Press towards the purple triangles as you go. This should measure 6 ½" when finished. It may be a little over you can trim it back but remember to ensure there is a quarter inch from the points for the seam allowance.

2. Sew a yellow 5" triangle to each edge of the Step 1 square. Press towards the yellow triangles as you go (unless this leaves an unsightly shadow). This should measure 9 ½" square.



3. Layer the 3" purple and the 3" yellow squares, right side together and cut in half diagonally. Sew down the diagonal side to make 16 half square triangles. Press seams towards the purple. These should measure 2 ½", you can trim them if they are over.



4. Sew 4 - Step 3 squares together using the diagram as a guide. Press seams towards the purple. Make 4 of these.

5. Sew a Step 4 row to the top and the bottom of the Step 2 square.




6. With the remaining Step 3 rows - add a 2½" square on each end. Make 2. Sew these on to the sides of the block. Give it a good press. It should measure 12 ½" square.

Congratulations you have finished the Bear Paws Block.

## 2010 Block of the Month PERFECTLY PURPLE

### Blocks 5 - Bear Paws and Twisted Star



#### REQUIREMENTS

From light purple fabric cut:-

4 - 2½" squares

1 - 3 ½" square cross cut twice into 4 triangles.


From orange fabric cut:-

2 - 3" squares and cross cut into 2 triangles each.


From yellow fabric cut:-

1 - 3 ½" square cross cut twice into 4 triangles.

1. Sew a purple triangle to the edge of a yellow triangle to produce a larger triangle. Ensure you get the purple and the yellow on the same sides for all 4 units.



2. Sew an Orange triangle to this unit to make a square. Make 4.



3. Lay the squares out according to the diagram above and sew accordingly. Press

The block should make 6½" square
