PERFECTLY PURPLE
Block 7 - Beach Boxes



REQUIREMENTS

Scraps of fabrics for beach houses

From Purple fabric cut:-	From Sky Blue fabric cut:-
1 - 11½" x 1½" rectangle	1 - 11½" x 2½" rectangle
1 - 11½" x 2½" rectangle	1 - 6" x 1½" rectangle
	1 - 6" x 2 ½" rectangle


From Yellow fabric cut:-
1 - 11½" x 1½" rectangle
2 - 6" x 1½" rectangles

This block is foundation pieced so you will also need some interfacing to trace 3 of the beach box patterns onto.

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
Block 7 - Beach Boxes



1. Sew the yellow and sky blue 6" x 1½" rectangles together. This will be used for the beach box units.
2. Trace 3 beach hut patterns onto interfacing or similar.
3. Use the foundation piecing method to attach the pieces in the correct order. Using your scraps.
4. When you get to pieces 8 and 9 use the strip prepared in step 1. Ensure the seam is on the line to create the correct parallel line.
5. Use sky blue fabric for Pieces 12 and 13.
5. Your beach hut should measure 3" x 3½" when you have finished. (this includes your seam allowance, the dotted line on your diagram).

6. Sew the 6" x 2½" sky blue rectangle to the 6 x 1½" yellow rectangle along the long side and cut 2 - 1 1/4" pieces. Cut the rest of the strip in half.

7. Join all the beach boxes together in the following order using the above pieces where told.



8. Sew the sky blue 11½" x 2½" rectangle to the top of the beach huts.
9. Sew the yellow 11½" x 1½" rectangle to the bottom of the beach huts.
10. Sew the purple 11½" x 2½" rectangle to the bottom of this block.
11. Sew the purple 11½" x 1½" rectangle to the top of this block.

Press. Your block should measure 11½" x 9 ½" rectangle. Trim the excess off each edge.
